

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) was created during 2009-10 and a modest start with an expenditure of Rs 30.92 crore was made. The draft approach to creating Unique Identification Numbers to every resident in India, concept papers describing the linkages of various welfare schemes steered by different Ministries/departments of Government of India and reports of the Demographic Data Standards and Field Verification Committee and Biometrics Committee were completed. The preparatory work for the Proof of Concept Studies and the Pilots were commenced. In the current year the Proof of Concept Studies and the pilots will be completed and the UID numbers will begin to be issued. Full scale enrolment of the resident and authentication services will be commenced towards the end of the year. The Managed Service Provider will be selected and the Central Data Identity Depository will be handed over on a long term contract basis. For this budget of Rs 1900.00 crores allocated during Annual Plan 2010-11. A major part of it is to be used for reimbursement of enrolment costs to the registrars as also to the residents.
