- (a) whether the Government is aware of the increasing number of cases involving Aadhaar related banking frauds;
- (b) if so, the details of Aadhaar related banking frauds reported during the last three years; and
- (c) the details of steps taken by the Government to avoid the recurrence of such Aadhaar related frauds?

- (a), (b) and (c): As per information received from Reserve bank of India (RBI), the data on total number of cases involving Aadhaar related banking frauds is not specifically captured and therefore, not available.
- RBI, NPCI, and Banks are undertaking adequate risk mitigation & consumer protection measures to minimize the occurrence of frauds in digital payments.
