

Candidates for UP board exams drop by 9 lakh

he number of candidates appearing for the UP secondary education board exams has decreased by a record nine lakh this year. Against 66 lakh candidates who registered in 2017, just 56 lakh registered by the last date, August 20, for the 2019 examination. Board officials attributed the drastic fall to the crackdown on the "cheating mafia" and Aadhaar being mandatory for registration. This year, 31.5 lakh have registered for Class 10 and 24.9 lakh for Class 12, P12

UP strike on cheating mafia scares away examinees

Lucknow: The number of candidates appearing for the Uttar Pradesh Secondary Education Board (UP-SEB) has decreased by a record 9 lakh this year. Against 66 lakh candidates who registered in 2017, just 56 lakh registered by the last date, August 20, for the 2019 examination.

Board officials attributed the fall in numbers to the crackdown on the 'cheating mafla' and Aadhaar being mandatory for registration.

"The crackdown on the copying mafia resulted in a

large number of students dropping out this year. Aadhaar being mandatory for registration has removed fake and multiple registrations," said UPSEB additional secretary (adminis-

tration) Shiv Lal.

"Online registration has checked fake candidates. It also seems that the number of students from other states who write the exams the help of cheating mafia has come down this year," said RP Mishra, state secretary, UP Secondary Education

Teachers' Association.

Until last year, the registration count was high as one candidate would apply from different colleges. Since registration was done manually, there was no check. Online registration has removed duplication, said a board official.

This year, the state government amended the forwarding policy, resulting in a decrease in the number private category students. Only 600 high school students and 400 intermediate students in the private category could be registered from any school.
