ON NEW WAYS TO LINK MOBILE NUMBER WITH AADHAAR: The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has introduced three new ways to link registered mobile number with Aadhaar — OTP (One Time Password) based, App based and the IVRS facility.

ON EASE OF ACCESS FOR LINKING NUMBER WITH AADHAAR: For the ease of senior citizens and people with disabilities and chronic illness, DoT has recommended re-verification at subscribers' doorstep. Telecom operators should provide an online mechanism for people to request such service and based on availability, schedule the visit.

ON NEED TO CONNECT AADHAAR WITH MOBILE: Mobile penetration is increasing and subscribers need to be provided with the ease of linking of the Aadhaar number with the mobile number.

ON MAINTAINING SUBSCRIBERS' PRIVACY:
Keeping with privacy rules, DoT has mandated that telecom service providers' agent don't have access to the subscribers' e-KYC data and only the name and address of the subscribers should be visible. Subscribers can verify or re-verify their mobile numbers.
