The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has urged Parents and Guardians to complete the Mandatory Biometric Update for Children Aged 7 and above. The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology said that under the current guidelines, a child below five years of age does not have to provide fingerprints or iris scans due to developmental reasons. It added that once the child turns five, these biometrics must be updated, and the process is free of charge if completed between the ages of 5 and 7. As per existing rules, if the Mandatory Biometric Update is not completed even after 7 years of age, the Aadhaar number may be deactivated. UIDAI has started sending SMS messages to the mobile numbers registered in the Aadhaar of such children for completing the Mandatory Biometric Update exercise.

After this period, the authority said it may cancel Aadhaar numbers issued to those who have not done the biometric update. The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) on Tuesday (July 15, 2025) urged parents of children between the age of 5 and 7 to update their kids' Aadhaar biometrics.

In the periodic reminder, the UIDAI said that the biometric update would be free of cost at enrolment centres, if done before children turned seven. After this period, the authority said it may cancel Aadhaar numbers issued to those who have not done the biometric update. A ₹100 fee applies if such an application is made after a child turns seven. on July 9 warned that Aadhaar numbers of children who enrolled before the age of five may be deactivated if their biometric details are not updated after they turn seven.

"UIDAI has started sending SMS messages to the mobile numbers registered in the Aadhaar of such children for completing the MBU (Mandatory Biometric Update) exercise," the press release said.

"The first Mandatory Biometric Update (MBU) must be completed between the age of five and seven years to avoid any fee. If the child performs the MBU between the age of five and seven years, it is free of cost. But after seven years of age, there is a prescribed fee of ₹100 only," it added.

According to a UIDAI official quoted by *PTI*, not updating biometrics could make it harder for children to benefit from programmes that rely on Aadhaar.

#### Aadhaar biometrics for children aged 5-7 free of charge

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) on Tuesday emphasised the importance of updating the Mandatory Biometric Update (MBU) for children who have reached the age of seven, but have not yet updated their biometrics in Aadhaar.

#### Update child's Aadhaar biometrics by age of 7: UIDAI

Lucknow: The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has stressed the need for parents to complete the Mandatory Biometric Update (MBU) for children aged 7 who haven't updated their Aadhaar biometrics.

"At the age of 5, the first MBU is required to capture fingerprints, iris, and an updated photo. This update is free if completed between ages 5 and 7.

After 7 years of age, a fee of Rs 100 is applicable," said official source.

Timely MBU completion ensures the accuracy and reliability of biometric data, preventing potential deactivation of the Aadhaar number if not updated post-7.

Parents have been urged to update their child's <u>Aadhaar</u> biometrics once the child turns seven, as per the existing guidelines under the Aadhaar framework. The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has reiterated the need to complete the Mandatory Biometric Update (MBU) for children who have not yet undergone the update. The Ministry of Electronics and IT clarified that the process can be completed at any Aadhaar Seva Kendra or designated Aadhaar centre.

The Aadhaar card is a 12-digit unique identification number issued by the Indian government to its citizens. It is a document that is often used as identification purpose and is required for various purposes such as availing government schemes and subsidies, opening bank accounts, and getting a passport.

While the Aadhaar card is primarily meant for adults, minors too can get their own Aadhaar card. Here is the process of applying for a minor Aadhaar card.
