(a)whether the Government proposes to make it mandatory for every citizen to get Aadhaar Card issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India;

(a)&(b): There is no such proposal under consideration of the Government, at this stage.

(c)&(d): Various Ministries, Departments and Agencies of Central and State Governments and Union Territory Administrations, that implement different schemes/programmes involving provision of benefits and/ or services, are encouraged to leverage Aadhaar for elimination of fakes and duplicates from the list of beneficiaries/consumers, increasing efficiency of implementation, and achieving higher levels of transparency in operations. In doing so, it has to be ensured that no eligible person suffers, or is denied any benefit or service, merely for the lack of an Aadhaar.
