80-year-old man suffering from Alzheimer gets Aadhaar Card

VARANASI: For 80-year-old Majid Hassan Khan, who has been suffering from Alzheimer and bedridden for the last six years, the local administration sent a team to his residence for making Aadhaar Card. After completing all processes, the Aadhaar Card was handed over to him in five days.

"We are grateful to the local authorities, who promptly responded to our request and provided Aadhaar Card in such a short period," said Nasim Fatma, the wife of ailing Majid. The family lives in a flat of Shastri Nagar in Sibra area. "My father lost his memory, and is completely bedridden. The service provided by the administration is really amazing," said their daughter Mini, who lives with the elderly couple to take care of them. She

said that her father had run his watch company in Dalmandi area before retiring to illness.

A team went to his house on January 4, and after completing the process, they provided Aadhaar Card on January 8. The family is overwhelmed with this compassionate attitude the local administration.

"We received the request through a NGO Satya Foundation that Majid is unable to move due to Alzheimer disease. We tried

our best to facilitate the elderly ailing citizens," said additional district magistrate (finance and revenue) Inshwar Chandra. "We also make an appeal to public just to inform us about such ailing persons, and we will be there to serve them," said Chandra.

Chetan Upadhyaya of Satya Foundation said that he came to know about the problem of the family and informed the concerned authorities.
