Chandigarh: Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) regional office held a meeting with Post Office (Punjab circle) to discuss about Aadhaar progress in post offices of Punjab and Himachal Pradesh.

Deputy director general of Chandigarh regional office of UIDAI Bhawna Garg held the meeting with chief postmaster general (CPMG) Anil Kumar, who has also been assigned additional charge of CPMG Himachal Pradesh.

Kumar assured full cooperation from the department for smooth and efficient delivery of Aadhaar services via post offices. For this, DoP (Department of Posts) has identified 503 post offices across Punjab and 254 in Himachal Pradesh.

Kumar requested UIDAI regional office Chandigarh to impart training to officials who are working on Aadhaar enrolment and updation services to help them eliminate errors done by the operator while providing Aadhaar services.
