Aadhaar operator tries to enrol Osama, booked

Jaipur: Police have booked an Aadhaar operator in Rajasthan's Bhilwara on Friday, for allegedly trying to get an Aadhaar card in the name of slain terrorist Osama bin Laden.

Saddam Mansuri, 35, who runs an Aadhaar registration centre in Mandal, allegedly attempted to enrol bin Laden's name. "Mansuri wrote Abbottabad, Bhilwara district, as the address, and uploaded a blurred picture of the terrorist. He didn't submit any ID proof, such as a thumb impression," Mandal DSP Chanchal Mishra said. The application soon came under UIDAI scanner.

"Mansuri has claimed that someone else may have uploaded the information," an IT department officer said. TNN
