(a): Yes, sir. The cost estimate for the second Phase includes project components for issue of 10 crore unique identification numbers by March 2011.

(b)&(c): There is no State wise allocation under the programme. The expenditure during the financial year 2009-10 was Rs.26.21 crore. The budget allocation for the current financial year 2010-11 is Rs.1900 crore. So far no amount has been spent by UIDAI for Andhra Pradesh.
