ISSUANCE OF AADHAAR CARDS ON FAKE DOCUMENTS

2958. SHRI LAL SINH VADODIA:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a rampant practice of issuing Aadhaar cards on the basis of fake documents in the country;
- (b) if so, whether Government proposes to take any steps to check it; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and by when, and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): No, Madam. There are well defined processes and guidelines that are followed for carrying out enrolment of Aadhaar. The same are mentioned in Chapter II (Resident Enrolment Process) in Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016. Corrective actions, wherever required, are taken as per relevant provisions of Aadhaar Act, 2016 and Regulations framed thereunder.

Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) conducts workshops from time-to-time for the enrolment agencies/operators sensitizing them on various issues relating to enrolment processes.
