MOU WITH VIJAYA BANK TO ASSIST UIDAI .

- (a) whether the Unique Identification Authority of India has signed any Memorandum of Understanding with Vijaya Bank to assist UIDAI;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) the details of the assignments given to Vijaya Bank;
- (d) whether UIDAI has already signed such agreements with other Banks; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the nature of assignments given to various banks in such agreements?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. A Memorandaum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by Vijaya Bank and UIDAI on 10 November, 2010.
- (c): The obligations of Vijaya Bank include enrollment of residents in accordance with the prescribed standards, protocol and processes laid down by UIDAI and the related obligations for implementation of the project.
- (d): Yes, Sir. MoUs have been signed with 20 Banks including Vijaya Bank, as of 22.11.2010.
- (e): The MoU provides the broad framework of the roles and responsibilities of UIDAI and registrars, in this case, the Banks concerned, for the implementation of the UID (Aadhaar) programme in the respective jurisdiction of the registrars. The roles and responsibilities and obligations of the Banks are similar in all cases.
