Bidders not possessing such experience with Central/State Government (either no experience or experience less than the prescribed number of assignments) will 'not receive any weightage/receive prorata weightage based on actual experience with State/Central Govt' out of the score assigned for experience with the Central/State Government.

Eg. A citation for the higher band say for Rs. 5 crore cannot be 5 citations of Rs. 1 crore.
