The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) invites bids from established reputed and reliable manufacturers of "Handheld Biometric Authentication Devices" or their sole authorized agents/distributors for "Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Biometric Authentication Devices".

- 2. Accordingly, you are requested to submitted quotations for supply, installation and commissioning of 20 Nos. of Handheld Biometric Authentication Devices with the Specifications listed in para 7 below .
- 3. The quotations, in a sealed cover, should reach the Deputy Director General, UIDAI, on or before **28**th **December' 2010 at 4.00 PM.**
- 4. The quotations, complete in all respects, should be dropped in the Tender Box located at 2nd Floor Tower-I Jeevan Bharati Building, Connaught Circus, New Delhi on or before the closing date and time indicated above, failing which the Quotations will be treated as late and rejected.
- 5. It should be noted that evaluation of the above mentioned item will be done in two parts i.e. Technical evaluation and Commercial evaluation. Therefore, Quotations in respect of above item should be submitted in two separate sealed covers i.e one for Technical and the other one for Commercial. The Sealed Covers should be super scribed with the wordings "Quotation for Handheld Biometric Authentication Device Technical " and "Quotation for Handheld Biometric Authentication Device Commercial" as the case may be.
- 6. It should also be noted that Techncial bids consist of complete brochure of the devices offered the bidder shall have to make available one Device of each type for Demonstration on the time and date indicated by UIDAI after opening the Technical bids. The Devices so offered shall be in the custody of UIDAI for a period of one month or placement of Purchase Order, whichever is earlier.

8. Payment Terms

8.1 Payment shall be made only after completion of supply, installation commissioning and acceptance of the Goods above, to the entire satisfaction of UIDAI or any other agency nominated by UIDAI.

- 8.2 The UIDAI may however, consider making advance payments which shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - i) An advance payment equivalent to 75% of the total value of the Goods and Services against proof of delivery and installation of system subject to the Vendor furnishing a bank guarantee on stamp paper of requisite value of an equivalent amount from any of the **Nationalised/Scheduled Bank** to indemnify Purchaser to the extent of any loss or damage sustained, in case the acceptance tests carried out on the Goods at the time of commissioning are not satisfactory.
 - ii) Balance 25% payment within 30 days of satisfactory commissioning and acceptance of the Goods/Services. In case the commissioning and acceptance of the Goods/Services is delayed or put off beyond 90 days of the receipt of the equipment at UIDAI's site due to express written instructions of the UIDAI, this amount may be released to the Vendor on his furnishing a necessary Bank Guarantee for an equivalent amount.
 - iii) No payment shall, however, accrue until after the Performance Guarantee Bond in the form of a Bank Guarantee (BG), which shall be equal to 10 % of the value of the order and valid upto date of expiry of warranty period, has been furnished. This BG shall be submitted by the selected Vendor within 10 days of issue of the firm purchase order by this office.
 - iv) It should be noted that installation, commissioning and acceptance, have to be duly certified by the ADG, Technology Centre, UIDAI, Bengaluru for release of payments as per 8.1 and 8.2 above.

8. It should be noted that,

- (i) Only Technically qualified bids would be considered for Commercial Evaluation.
- (ii) The purchaser reserves the right at the time of award of Contract to increase or decrease the quantity of goods specified above without any change in price or other terms and conditions. The UIDAI also reserves the right to split the award of contract to one or more Bidders and for one or more types of devices.
- (iii) The Purchaser reserves the right to accept some or all of the technically qualified bid(s) and to annul the Tender process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Tenderer or Tenderers or any obligation to inform the affected Tenderer or Tenderers of the grounds for the Purchaser's action.
- (iv) The above mentioned items have to be supplied, installed and commissioned either at Delhi or Bengaluru.
- (v) The vendor will provide the acceptance testing schedule at least 10 days before the due date of delivery.
- (vi) The vendor has to ensure that the name, address, date of delivery and stamp (of the office where delivered), are clearly visible on the duly signed proof of delivery.
- (vii) Any unjustified and unacceptable delay in delivery beyond delivery schedule will render the vendor liable for damage at the rate of 0.2% (zero point two percent) per day subject to a maximum of 40 days and thereafter UIDAI holds the option for cancellation of the order and forfeiture of performance and impose cancellation charge of 10% of the order value.
- (viii) The Devices ordered should be installed immediately on delivery or latest within **15 days** from the date of purchase order whichever is earlier.
- (ix) Any delay in installation of delivered item(s) attracts a penalty of Installation Penalty Percentage 0.2% of PO value per day subject to a maximum of 40 days from due date of installation. Therefore, UIDAI holds the option to complete installation work through alternate sources at the risk and cost of the defaulting vendor.

- (x) The items supplied would be under Three Years Comprehensive Warranty and free support service from the date of installation and acceptance, including free provision of spare part as and when necessary The vendor should fulfill the following condition during the warranty period:
 - (a) Any failure in the system or a subsystem thereof should be rectified within maximum period of 24 hours of lodging complaint.
 - (b) If any of the system/subsystem is down beyond 24 hours, penalty will be charged per hour per system/subsystem at the rate of Rs.1000/-(Rupees One Thousand Only.)
